In August 2014, ISIS attacked Sinjar. Hundreds of thousands of Yazidis and other minorities were displaced overnight. More than a decade later, close to two-thirds of Sinjar's population is still displaced, and the disruption to education and economic opportunity continues to shape the lives of an entire generation.

Access to quality education and meaningful employment is limited, with women, displaced people, and those without digital skills facing some of the greatest barriers.





An educational nonprofit built for Sinjar's future.

Sinjar Academy is a U.S.-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit and educational institution serving Sinjar, Ba'aj, Rabia, and Talafar. Together, those districts are home to roughly 800,000 of Iraq's ethnic and religious minorities.

Founded in 2022, Sinjar Academy uses a hybrid educational model. The school combines virtual instruction from educators around the world with face-to-face programming in Sinuni, providing access to high-quality education where it's needed most.

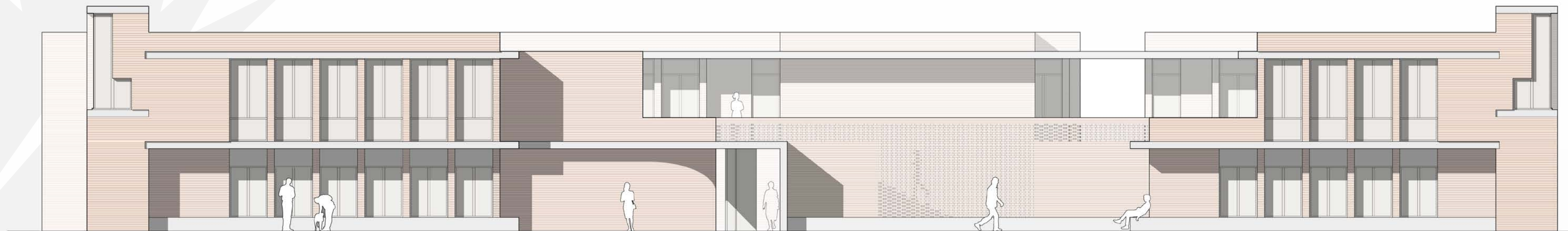

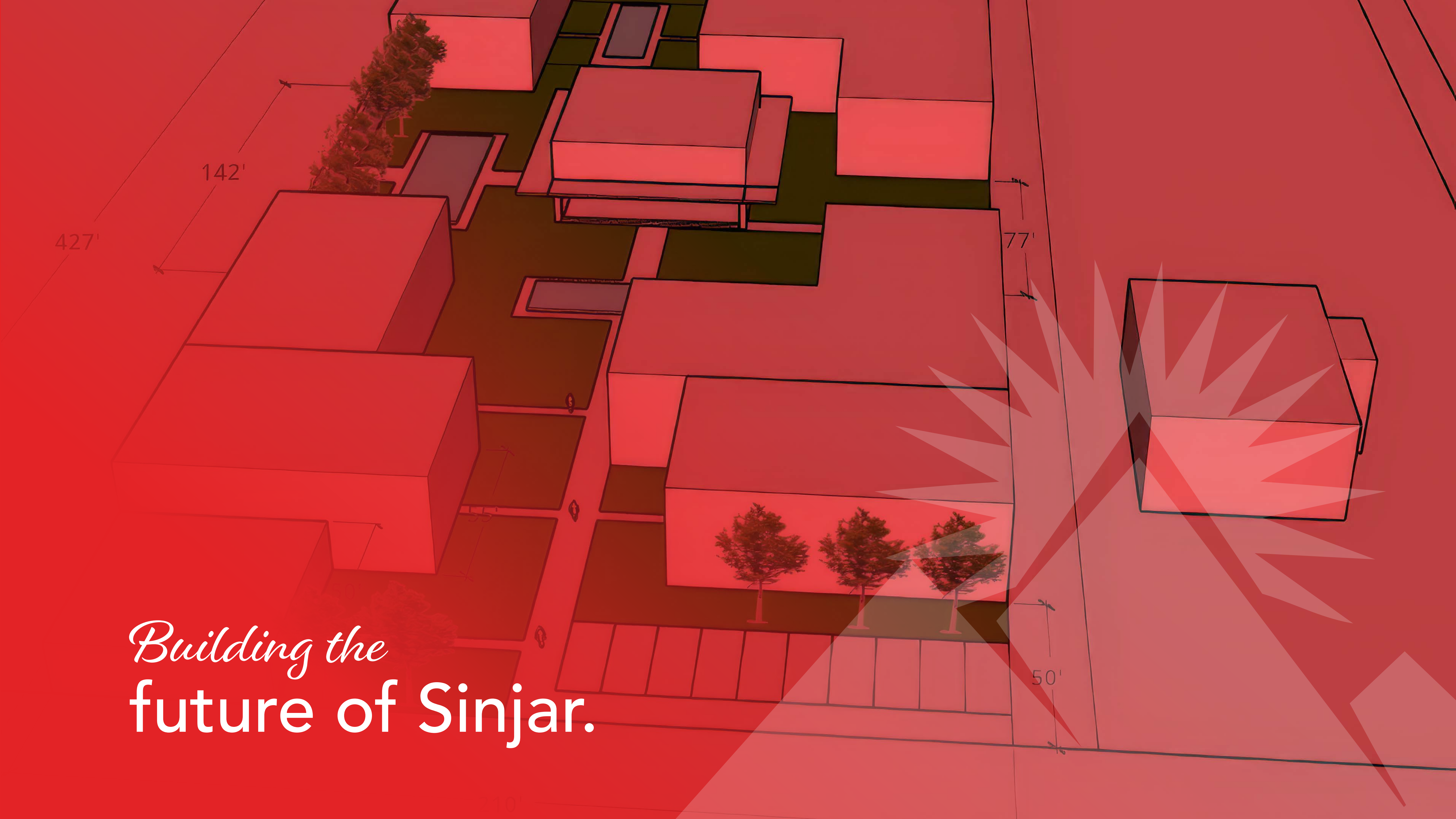
